When should a child be referred to Language Express?

- If you are concerned about speech/language/hearing development
- If your child's speech and language skills have not improved over the past six months
- If your child often repeats sounds and/or words (stuttering)
- If your child's voice sounds different to you
- If your child's play or social interaction seems inappropriate
- If your child has a diagnosis such as cleft lip/palate, hearing loss, PDD/Autism or developmental delay
- If your child is not meeting one or more of the milestones for his or her age



The early years of a child's life are important for the development of language and communication. Long before a child starts to talk she is learning about communication.
