Use simple words to talk about what you are doing while you are doing it. Show what you mean.



At mealtime use simple words to talk about what you're eating or doing: "Do you want milk or juice?" "I love spaghetti!" "What a mess!"

Go for a walk together and tell your child the names of things he is interested in: "Look! A bird" "That bird is making a nest."



Say rhymes and make up your own silly rhymes together:

"Tickle your neck, tickle your nose.
Tickle your tummy, tickle your toes!"
